Vista Curriculum

Vista is the name of our new curriculum in the T.H. Chan School of Medicine. Launched in 2022, there are three phrases: Discovery, Exploration and Horizons. Vista focuses on using simulation and technology for learning, incorporating equity, social determinants of health and student well-being. With Vista, UMass Chan offers a parallel accelerated three-year MD program for students with a preselected match at a UMass Chan generalist residency program.

UMass Chan also has two regional campuses, each with a unique academic emphasis and learning opportunities. You select your campus with your application.

UMass Chan-Baystate, located in Springfield, Massachusetts, is home to the Population-based Urban and Rural Community Health (PURCH) track. PURCH adds to the Vista curriculum with an added focus on population health, health care disparities and health issues specific to urban and rural communities.

UMass Chan-Lahey, located in Burlington, Massachusetts, is home to the innovative LEAD@Lahey track, which adds to the Vista curriculum with an added focus on leadership, health systems science and interprofessional education.

Candidates for our regional campus tracks must complete an additional application essay and a campus-specific interview. Approximately 25 students are admitted to each track annually.

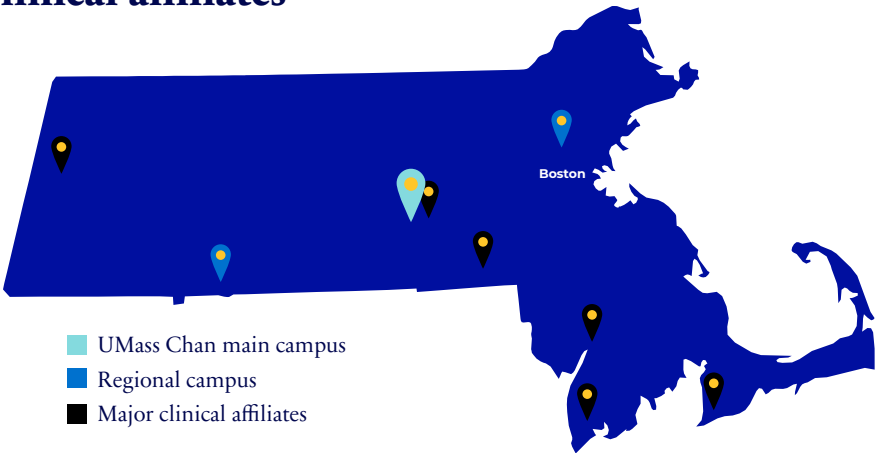

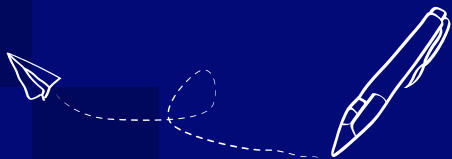

Application timeline and requirements

- Application requirements:
 - Verified AMCAS application
 - Letters of recommendation
 - MCAT score
 - AAMC PREview (Professional Readiness Exam)
 - T.H. Chan School of Medicine Secondary Application Forms
 - Application fee
- AMCAS application deadline: mid-October (see AMCAS website for exact date)
- Secondary application deadline: December 1
- Applications undergo holistic review by our Admissions Committee, which is diverse and has strong student representation. The Medical School adheres strictly to all applicable state and federal regulations relating to nondiscrimination and equal opportunity.
- We hold virtual multiple-mini interviews from September through March. An additional round of interviews is required for applicants to our PURCH track, LEAD@Lahey track and MD/PhD program.
